HELLO AGAIN!

During these months, the partners have been working on identifying good practices and developing the manual.

Finally, a total of 19 good practices has been compiled, from which a committee of experts has selected the four best ones to develop an implementation manual.

What have we done so far?

On October 1, 2024, International Day of Older Persons was celebrated. The partners produced a video in the different languages of the project (English, Spanish, Greek, and Italian) with the aim of raising awareness among the population about the existence of older persons with autism, a group that is still invisible and for whom measures to improve their quality of life are urgently needed.

Likewise, during the first weeks of October, the four partner entities held events in their cities with the aim of raising awareness among the population.
